What is The Carolina Action Network?

Established in 2015 by the University's Alumni Association, the Carolina Action Network (CAN) is a grassroots network of alumni, students, employees, parents and friends of the university who are committed to helping raise awareness of the important role UofSC plays in improving the lives of all South Carolinians and sharing that message with elected officials.

What do CAN Members do?

As a CAN Member you will be part of a network of 1,500+ volunteers who work together to express their support for UofSC with their elected officials. Members communicate with elected officials in various ways including e-mails, letters, phone calls, and personal visits.

What are the Expectations?

Becoming a CAN member can take as little or as much time as you would like. Your voice and willingness to become involved are all that is required. Upon joining, you will be asked to participate in a survey that will help us understand how you can help support the university's advocacy needs. You will also be encouraged but not required to attend events such as regional networking events, and Carolina Day.

How Much Does a Membership Cost?

No membership fees are required to become a member.

You are not required to attend any meetings however we encourage you to participate in our regional networking events, and Carolina Day.

What is Carolina Day?

Carolina Day is the University's annual legislative day. Supporters from across the UofSC system are invited to the State House to meet with their elected officials and show their support for UofSC.
